The pieces also make reference to the Buddhist mantra of Nam Miojo Renge Kyo of the Nichiren Daishonin Buddhism.

It invites the individual to chant Nam Miojo Renge Kyo as a method for creating good karma and for cleansing themselves of the bad ones. It works as a form of liberation that is able to break our fastenings in life.
